With an effective date of September 1, 2018, the company will be known as Ag Partners Cooperative, Inc. and will be headquartered in Seneca, KS. This unification will allow for many opportunities as well as keeping local control with equal board representation. A more efficient utilization of assets and employees will help position the company to compete in a growing agriculture industry and be better equipped to continue to provide the best products and services to its patrons.
