We have definitely hit our busiest time of year with harvest being upon us. We wish you a very safe and bountiful harvest this season! Our Energy Department has a lot of moving parts this time of year as well. We greatly appreciate your business!

We are currently finishing up our summer-fill propane routes. If you feel like we may have missed you, please do not hesitate in giving us a call so that we can make sure we get you on one of our routes. We have had many calls already from customers thinking that they missed out on the summer-fill special price. This is not true! We will continue to honor that price until we are positive we have gotten to everyone on our list.

A quick reminder to our propane customers. If you are on a call-in basis, please try and keep an eye on your tank and give us a call when your tank is at around 20%-25%. This will ensure that we have a couple of days to get to you.

This reminder also applies to our refined fuel customers. If you are able to call us a day in advance, that really helps us efficiently get our routes coordinated and enable us to effectively serve you and take care of your needs. As always, we will strive to get to you the same day!

Fall time is a perfect time of year to do tank maintenance for your on-farm storage. This includes draining your tanks and also replacing filters. If you would like us to replace filters for you, please let us know when you place your fuel order with us.

We have recently installed a brand new Ruby Diesel pump at our Seneca location! It is located on the south end of our bulk fuel plant, just on the east side of our scale house. This pump will only accept our in-house Coop proprietary cards. You must also have a tax exemption form signed and on file with us in order to utilize this dispenser. If you have questions about this, please give our office a call.

Lisa Clevenger recently started her employment with us in our Energy Department. Her main duties will be on the accounting side for all of our fuel, propane and lubricants. You will likely speak with her when placing fuel orders, or if you have questions about your bill. We are very excited to have her on board with us!

Fuel markets continue to stay low at this time. We believe it is an advantageous time for you to seriously consider locking in your fuel gallons for next year. If you would like to get more information on this, please give me a call and I will be more than happy to explain our different options that we have available to help you take advantage of these low prices.
