## Qualifications

- Must be a member or designated voting representative of a member of Agtegra Cooperative
  - Bona-fide agricultural producer
  - Not less than \$10,000 in business during previous fiscal year
- Less than 70 years of age at time of election
- Up to two Nonvoting Advisory Directors from different districts are appointed
- Cannot be an employee of Agtegra Cooperative
- Primary occupation must be as a farmer or rancher
- Must complete a background check and agree to sign the Director and Officer Code of Conduct, a Confidentiality Agreement, and the Director Conflict of Interest Policy and Disclosure Form
