Because of the size and speed of this new facility, CRC has evaluated its plant service areas and how to best provide core business services to patron members. Management must find ways to best utilize all of CRC's facilities, rolling stock and employees.

Agronomy service locations will consist of Sleepy Eye East, Fairfax, Buffalo Lake and seasonally in Sleepy Eye West and Cosmos. Changes to agronomy locations will consist of the following:

- The former Gibbon and Fairfax agronomy locations will move operations to the new facility at 48153 State Highway 19, Fairfax MN.
