Scholarship Application – CLASS OF 2023

Country Visions Cooperative and CP Feeds, LLC will be awarding scholarships to a total of 33 area students who will each receive a \$1,000 scholarship award through this partnership of our companies.

Eligibility:

- The 2023 graduating high school senior must be enrolled for the upcoming school year in an undergraduate degree program by an accredited college or university, or planning to attend a vocational or technical school.
- The parents, parent, or legal guardian of the student must be a member of Country Visions Cooperative or CP Feeds, LLC and have purchased at least \$2000 worth of goods and services in the year prior to application from Country Visions, CP Feeds or the former CHS Larsen Cooperative. **(Three of the scholarships will be awarded as an Employee Scholarship.** Student employees, or children of employees, are eligible for this scholarship without meeting the purchase requirement, but still must meet the other eligibility requirements. They must be an employee of Country Visions Cooperative or CP Feeds at the time the application is submitted.) A student may qualify for the employee scholarship and the Country Visions/CP Feeds scholarship, but only 1 scholarship will be awarded per student.
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale during their previous educational years.

Requirements:

1. Complete the application form and return to Country Vision Cooperative along with all requested documents.
2. Attach a transcript from your high school through your most recently completed semester.
3. Include two letters of recommendation. (At least one should be from an employer, community leader, teacher or principal)
4. If chosen as a scholarship winner, the student will need to complete one (1) semester of college or technical school to receive the funds. After successful completion of a semester of college, students must submit a copy of their grade report and proof of enrollment for second semester.
5. If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be asked to furnish a photograph of yourself for publication. High resolution digital photos will also be accepted.

Deadline:

Applications, including all required data, must be postmarked, emailed or delivered to Country Visions office **by March 31, 2023** without exception.

Judging:

The combined Country Visions Cooperative and CP Feeds, LLC Scholarship Fund Selection Committee has sole authority for granting scholarship awards. Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of academic performance, recommendations, essay question response, extra-curricular activities, employment experience and completion of application. **Preference will be given to students majoring in agriculture.**

Finalists and their schools will be notified during May 2023. All selections are considered final. All applications and attachments become the property of Country Visions Cooperative and CP Feeds, LLC Scholarship Committee.
