Job Title: Feed Truck Driver

Job Objective

Incumbent drives a semi tractor-trailer combination or a truck to transport and deliver goods, livestock, or materials in liquid, loose, or packaged form. Required to load truck and assist others with loading truck. Required to unload truck. Incumbent will complete all duties in a manner that will optimize the cooperative's market share and savings, improve the cooperative's efficiency, help achieve the cooperative's mission and goals, and result in outstanding customer service.

Other responsibilities include all activities consistent with the corporate objectives, purpose, and mission of the company. Employee will assist other departments as needed and will have other duties as assigned by management

This position will maintain a positive attitude that promotes team work within the department, as well as within the cooperative and upholds a favorable image of Five Star Cooperative at all times.

Qualifications

Education: High School diploma or equivalent; fluent reading, writing, and speaking the English language

License, Certificate or Registration: Class A CDL with tanker and hazmat endorsements; valid DOT physical card; Pesticide Handlers License; Iowa Commercial Applicators license with 1A, 1B, 1C, and seed treatment.

Basic Skills: Speaking, Writing, Reading Comprehension, Listening, Monitoring, Judgment and Decision Making, Time Management

Essential Tasks

- Drives trucks with capacities greater than 3 tons, including tractor-trailer combinations, in order to transport and deliver products, livestock, or other materials
- Load and unload trucks, or help others with loading and unloading, operating any special loading-related equipment on vehicles and using other equipment as necessary

- Maneuver trucks into loading or unloading positions, following signals from loading crew as needed; check that vehicle position is correct and any special loading equipment is properly positioned
- Couple and uncouple trailers by changing trailer jack positions, connecting or disconnecting air and electrical lines, and manipulating fifth-wheel locks
- Follow appropriate safety procedures when transporting dangerous goods
- Performs pre-trip inspections of vehicles before driving them to ensure that mechanical, safety, and emergency equipment is in good working order.
- Maintains logs of working hours and of vehicle service and repair status, following applicable company, state, and federal regulations
- Obtains receipts or signatures when loads are delivered, and collects payment for services when required.
- Check all load-related documentation to ensure that it is complete and accurate
- Secures cargo for transport, using ropes, blocks, chains, binders, and /or covers.
- Reads bills of lading to determine assignment detail
- Reports vehicle defects, accidents, traffic violations, or damage to the vehicle.
- Reads and interprets maps in order to determine vehicle routes.
- Collects delivery instructions from appropriate sources, verifies instructions and routes.
- Operates equipment such as truck cab computers, CB radios, and telephones to exchange necessary information with bases, supervisors or other drivers.
- Checks condition of trailers after content has been unloaded to ensure there is no damage
- Cranks trailer landing gear up or down to safety secure vehicles.
- Enforce and abide by all cooperative policies
- Maintain quality control above the standards set by Five Star
- Exhibits integrity and professional attitude

Maintenance & Safety:

- Observe all state, federal , OSHA, safety and environmental regulations
- Maintain delivery equipment, application equipment, and fertilizer and seed plant's equipment and facilities regularly
- Maintain compliance with entering data and completing monthly preventative maintenance schedule
- Maintain clean and neat facilities
- Maintain housekeeping and sanitation standards
- Upholds Five Star's Safety regulations and procedures

Service:

- Excellent customer service required – Applicant must be neat and approachable
- Handles customer complaints smoothly
 - Notifies supervisor of problems
 - Solves the problem as quickly as possible, either personally or through communication with the supervisor
- Excellent telephone skills – applicant must promptly and courteously answer the phone
- Requires acute attention to detail

- Requires making decisions that affect customers, other employees, Five Star Coop's financial resources, and/or the image and reputation of the organization
- Commitment to excellence and high standards
- Actively work to increase personal skills and knowledge
- Attend product, merchandising, safety, and cooperative meetings as requested

Other Duties:

- Enforce and uphold the cooperative's credit policy
- Good communication with all employees and customers
- Check with other departments to see if help is needed before going home.
- Work as a team member and maintain a positive attitude that promotes team work within the cooperative and a favorable image of the cooperative.
- Perform other duties as assigned my management - employees duties may change according to the changing needs of the company.
- Enforce and abide by all cooperative policies
- Strong organizational, problem solving, and analytical skills; able to manage priorities and workflow
- Ability to deal effectively with a diversity of individuals at all organizational levels
- Good judgment with the ability to make timely and sound decisions
- Versatility, flexibility, and a willingness to work within constantly changing priorities with enthusiasm
- Ability to work independently and as a team player
- Must be able to climb stairs, reach above, below, and at shoulder level.
- Willingness to work from multiple locations with in the coop

Work Conditions and Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. This job is performed indoors or outdoors in weather extremes of Northern Iowa. Exposure to dust from feed, grain, or fertilizer products.

Physical Abilities

- **Far Vision**—The ability to see details at a distance.
- **Near Vision**—The ability to see details at close range to complete detailed paperwork and computer work(within a few feet of the observer).
- **Reaction Time**—The ability to quickly respond (with the hand, finger, foot) to a signal (sound, light, picture) when it appears.
- **Static Strength**—The ability to exert maximum muscle force to lift, push, pull, or carry objects.
- **Response Orientation**—The ability to choose quickly between two or more movements in response to two or more different signals (lights, sounds, pictures). It includes the speed with which the correct response is started with the hand, foot, or other body part.
- **Spatial Orientation**—The ability to know your location in relation to the environment or to know where other objects are in relation to you.
- **Depth Perception**—The ability to judge which of several objects is closer or further away from you, or to judge the distance between you and an object.
- **Extent Flexibility**—The ability to bend, stretch, twist, or reach with your body, arms, and/or legs.
- **Multilimb Coordination**—The ability to coordinate two or more limbs (for example, two arms, two legs, or one leg and one arm) while sitting, standing, or lying down. It does not involve performing the activities while the whole body is in motion.
- **Manual Dexterity**—The ability to quickly move your hand, your hand together with your arm, or your two hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble or move objects
- **Climbing**—Ability to climb stairs.
