Full Circle Ag 2022 Careers in Agriculture Scholarship Application

Eligibility: Students pursuing a two-year or four-year degree in agronomy or related crop production, or closely related fields. Available to high school seniors graduating in 2022 and to students currently enrolled in a two-year or four-year relevant program. Applicants must live within the Full Circle Ag trade territory to be eligible. Applications must be signed by a school official, and postmarked by April 15, 2022.

Description: \$500-\$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to high school seniors and currently enrolled college students; based upon scholastic achievement, leadership in agriculture, and a perceived ability to contribute to agriculture in the future.
