



FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

The daily amount of food cats need is influenced by the environmental temperature, and their activity, size, and breed. The chart below shows the cups of Hi Point Cat Food that is required daily to maintain condition and to support a normal level of activity in adult cats of varying sizes.

Amounts are based on a standard measuring cup. A cup will hold about 3 1/3 ounces of Hi Point Cat Food.

CALORIE CONTENT: 3232 Kcal/Kg and 308 Kcal/cup (Calculated Metabolizable Energy).

FEEDING GUIDELINES:

Adjust the amount fed according to the cat's appetite and condition. Young and extremely active cats may require and consume one and one-half to three times the amount of food indicated for their weight on the chart. Fresh food and water should be always available.
