



IAS FFA Community Impact Challenge: Official Contest Rules

Sponsor The IAS FFA Community Impact Challenge is sponsored by Innovative Ag Services (IAS).

Eligibility to Enter Open to active FFA chapters within the IAS service area in Iowa and Wisconsin. One entry per chapter. Entries must be submitted by an authorized FFA advisor or school representative.

Entry Period Entries will be accepted from February 4 through February 20, 2026. Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered.

How to Enter Chapters must submit chapter information, a brief project description (150–250 words), intended use of funds, and optional photo or video through the [official online form](#). No purchase or payment is required.

Project Criteria Projects should support agricultural education, leadership development, career exploration, or community service connected to agriculture and align with IAS values.

Selection of Finalists IAS will review all submissions and select three to five finalist chapters based on impact, alignment with goals, and clarity of need. Finalist selection is determined solely by IAS.

Voting Voting is open to IAS employees, members, customers, and community supporters. Voting will take place online during FFA Week. Limit one vote per person. Duplicate or fraudulent votes may be removed. IAS reserves the right to determine final results in the event of ties or irregularities.

Prizes First Place: \$1,000. Second Place: \$500. Funds will be issued directly to the chapter or school and must be used for chapter or project purposes only.

Use of Submissions By entering, the chapters grant IAS permission to use project descriptions, names, photos, and videos for promotional and educational communications.

General Conditions IAS reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the contest if necessary to protect fairness or integrity. All decisions are final.
