Scholarship Overview:

- **IAS Scholarship:** Open to high school seniors and first-year college students whose parent or guardian is a patron of IAS. Recipients must pursue a degree in an agriculture-related field.
- **IAS Dependent Scholarship:** This scholarship is available exclusively to high school seniors and first-year college students of current IAS employees, providing financial assistance to help advance their education in agriculture.
