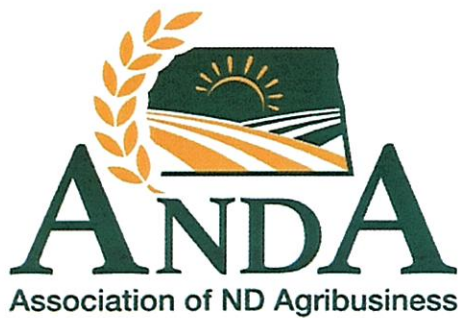




Scholarship Application Information
