2024 Harvest Programs

Short Term Open Storage: Producers will have **<u>15 days from the first unload date</u>** to decide if grain is to be sold or stored. If the grain is not sold then DP charges will start from the average date of unload for that 15 day period.

Spot Pricing: Pricing can be done over the scale Monday – Friday from 7am – 6pm. Bushels dumped during the weekend will be placed on open that can be sold on Monday.

<u>Check pickup</u>: During Harvest checks will be ready for pick up the following Morning by 10am at our main office.

Delayed Price:

Soybeans: 6.5 cents per month prorated by the day must be priced by 10.15.25.if not priced by then a .15 cent roll fee will be added.

<u>Corn</u>: 6.5 cents per month prorated by the day must be priced by 10.15.25.if not priced by then a .15 cent roll fee will be added.

Above charges are <u>Subject to change at any time</u>. If grain is not priced by <u>Oct 15th</u> 2025 there will be a 15 cent rollover fee and placed on <u>New Crop 25 DP Program</u>. All DP contracts must be signed and returned with 30 Days.

Producers that place grain on Delayed Price lose beneficial interest of that grain. We must know; <u>Who's grain it is, Splits of that grain (if any), and what is to be</u> <u>done with the grain before the load can be dumped.</u> With this proper information it will help speed up dumping time. Once the grain is sold it cannot be changed. When picking up your tickets make sure all information is correct.
