**FEEDING DIRECTIONS:** Co-op Pinnacle Horse Supplement Block is designed to be a convenient means of providing protein, vitamins and minerals often lacking in southeastern forages. Feed only to adult horses when good-quality forage is fed free-choice and clean, fresh water is available at all times. Horses should consume 0.5 to 1.5 lb per 1,000 lb of body weight daily. Use is not recommended with horses confined to stalls or small paddocks due to possible overconsumption. If horses consume more than 2 lb per 1,000 lb of body weight per day, discontinue use and visit with a Co-op Feed Specialist to develop an appropriate feeding program. Do not feed more than 3 mg of supplemental selenium per head per day. 1.9 lb of this block will provide 3 mg of selenium.

**CAUTION:** Do not feed to sheep or other copper-sensitive animals.
