

# CO-OP 37% PELLETTED SHEEP CONCENTRATE-BOV MEDICATED

For Growing and Finishing Lambs

For the prevention of coccidiosis caused by *Eimeria ovina*, *Eimeria crandallis*, *Eimeria ovinoidalis* (*Eimeria ninakohlyakimovae*), *Eimeria parva* and *Eimeria intricata* in sheep maintained in confinement.

## INGREDIENTS

Plant Protein Products, Processed Grain By-Products, Calcium Carbonate, Animal Protein Products, Molasses Products, Propionic Acid, Salt, Animal Fat and Vegetable Oil with Ethoxyquin (a preservative), Urea, Ammonium Chloride, Magnesium Sulfate, Potassium Sulfate, Calcium Phosphate, Selenium Yeast, Ferrous Sulfate, Manganous Oxide, Zinc Oxide, Cobalt Carbonate, Ethylenediamine Dihydriodide, Sodium Molybdate, Sodium Selenite, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D-3 Supplement, Vitamin E Supplement.

**FEEDING DIRECTIONS:** Mix 1 part of Co-op 37% Pelleted Sheep Concentrate-BOV with 3 parts of grain to make a 16% protein mixed ration containing 30 g of Lasalocid per ton. Feed the mixed ration continuously at 1.00 to 4.66 lb per head per day depending on bodyweight to provide not less than 15 mg nor more than 70 mg of Lasalocid per head per day. Lambs should be fed twice a day and worked up to a full feed of the 16% mixed ration over a 2 to 3 week period of time. To maintain rumen health and prevent digestive upset, feed 0.50 to 0.75lb of fine stemmed hay per head per day along with the full feed of the 16% mixed ration and the lambs are on full feed, then hay does not need to be fed.

**CAUTION:** The safety of Lasalocid for use in unapproved species has not been established. Do not allow horses or other equines access to feeds containing Lasalocid as ingestion may be fatal. Mix thoroughly with grain and/or roughage prior to feeding. Feeding undiluted or mixing errors may result in an excess Lasalocid concentration which could be fatal to cattle and sheep.
