This internship will expose the student to all aspects of Agronomy; crop production, Integrated Pest Management, the use of in season satellite imagery, soil fertility, irrigation, crop rotation, plant physiology, weed, insect & disease identification with emphasis on how to control these pests. Experiences will include a variety of assigned tasks, with the goal to benefit from as many different experiences as possible through hands on crop scouting, operational responsibilities, and interactions with the producers and our own agronomists.

- Soil, Tissue, and Nematode testing.
- General operational duties to assist in the delivery & application of seed, fertilizer & crop protection products.
- Scout customers fields and accurately report back information to the agronomy team.
- Accurately place agronomy marketing signage along local highways.
- Complete weekly reports every Friday afternoon.
- Complete special projects for the agronomy sales team & management as needed.
- Perform all other duties as assigned.
- Work in a team atmosphere with the rest of the agronomy staff.
- Create an informative PowerPoint presentation of your internship experience.
