## INGREDIENTS

Oats, Dehulled Soybean Meal, Wheat Middlings, Molasses Products, Corn Distillers Dried Grains with Solubles, Beet Pulp, Vegetable Oil with Tertiary Butyl Hydroquinone (a preservative), Calcium Carbonate, Calcium Phosphate, Salt, Magnesium Oxide, Lysine, Zinc Methionine Complex, Manganese Methionine Complex, Copper Lysine Complex, Cobalt Glucoheptonate, Vitamin E Supplement, Selenium Yeast, dl-Methionine, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D-3 Supplement, Lignin Sulfonate, Ascorbic Acid, *Yucca schidigera* Extract, Copper Sulfate, Zinc Sulfate, Zinc Oxide, Manganous Oxide, Manganese Sulfate, Sodium Selenite, Cobalt Carbonate, Calcium Iodate, Propionic Acid (a preservative), Acetic Acid, Sodium Propionate (a preservative), Ammonium Hydroxide, Sorbic Acid (a preservative), Magnesium Aluminosilicate, Sodium Bentonite, Calcium Bentonite.

**FEEDING DIRECTIONS:** Co-op Pinnacle Futurity is designed to provide high-quality protein and energy to broodmares, foals and yearlings. Follow recommended feeding rates below. Feed similar amounts at the same time each day to minimize digestive upset. Monitor the horse's body condition and adjust feeding practices to maintain an appropriate level of condition. If feeding a grain ration at a rate of 0.5 lb per 100 lb of body weight per day or more, divide total amount into 2 or 3 individual meals offered over 10 to 12 hours. Avoid abrupt changes in feed or forage type. Implement any changes to the diet over a 7- to 10-day transitional period. Changes in the amount of a grain ration should not exceed 1.0 to 1.5 lb per day. Provide free-choice access to clean, fresh water and salt at all times. Store feed in a dry area protected from insects and rodents.

\* Feeding rates are expressed as total lb of Pinnacle Futurity per head per day. The feeding directions above assume horses are consuming at least 1.5% of their body weight in good-quality forage daily. Feeding amounts should be adjusted proportionately for horses with an ideal mature body weight of under 600 lb or over 1500 lb. Feed amounts may be adjusted up or down as needed to maintain ideal body condition. Mares consuming less than 0.4% of body weight (4 lb for a 1000 lb horse) and growing horses consuming less than 0.8% of body weight (4 lb for a 500 lb weanling) should be switched to Pinnacle Balancer for a lower calorie, more concentrated source of essential nutrients. Nursing foals may be fed Pinnacle Futurity to supplement mare's milk. Feed nursing foals no more than 0.8% of body weight (2 lb for a 250 lb foal) per day.
