**FEEDING DIRECTIONS:** The grain requirement for a lactating doe is about 1 lb of Co-op 16% Coarse Goat Feed for each 2 lb of 5.5% butterfat milk. She should receive 1 lb of Co-op 16% Coarse Goat Feed for each 2.5 lb of 4.0% butterfat milk. Total grain intake should be less than 50% of dry matter intake to avoid rumen upsets or butterfat depression. Provide good-quality forage or pasture and clean, fresh water at all times.
